Selectmen's meeting minutes September 21st, 2010

Attendance- Bob Drew, Turf Ramsden, and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox, Gene Spender and Scott Gardiner were also there.

1. We accepted the minutes of last weeks' meeting. Bob made the motion and Turf seconded it. All voted in favor.
2. We revisited the fuel bids. We awarded the bid to B&L Oil. They were the lowest bidder.
3. Steve spent some time in the morning with Time Warner looking for cable at Mountain View Pines.
4. Steve met with Buzz and the claims investigator regarding a pending legal issue.
5. Buzz is working on the deed to the Prescott Land.
6. We received two thank you letters for our support to their agencies. One was from Home Health Visiting Nurses and one was from the American Red Cross.
7. Howard Corwin came in to discuss milfoil. He discussed with the town his ideas on how we, the Selectman should take the lead and be very proactive in our approach to this. He felt that the proposals from other groups were not strong enough and he shared with us some of his ideas. A copy of some information is in the minutes.
8. Gene also discussed some of his ideas about milfoil.
9. We signed the warrant.
10. We received a request from the New Suncook Playground Building Group. Bob called them and told them to resubmit this in early December and we would give it to the budget committee.
11. We received a letter from Lynn Stockford to protest an increase in access points to Kezar on Lower Bay. She had referenced 2 potential access points. We, the Selectman have not been advocating for any new landings on the lake. There was a discussion at a planning board meeting a few months ago.
12. We received a routine notice from Time Warner about their channels.
