Selectmen's meeting minutes January 25, 2011

Attendance- Bob Drew, Turf Ramsden, and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox was also present.

1. We met with the budget committee for our first meeting. Those present were Mark Moulton, Scott Thomas, Scott Gardiner, Kathy Vachowski, Robbie Drew, Joe Moody, Jon Bliss, Al St.Germain, Althea Foster and Bob Stellar. We discussed all budget items. Ed Nista was there to present the LIPPC budget request and Mary Heroux was there to present the Library's budget request. Our next meeting will be next Tuesday night.
2. Bob made the motion to accept the minutes from the last week, Steve seconded it and all voted in favor.
3. We signed a game of chance license for the snowmobile club.
4. We discussed our banking situation. Apparently Northeast Bank will no longer offer a cash management account. Steve has put out a request for bids with Key Bank, TD Bank and Norway Savings Bank. In the interim we need to divest ourselves of monies held at Northeast so Steve has set up with Sherry accounts at three other banks so we are covered under the FDIC guidelines. We agreed and voted on drafting up a letter to allow Sherry the Town Clerk to open up additional Bank accounts if needed. (All were in favor)
5. We signed the warrant.
6. We received information from Time Warner.
7. We received an invitation from Oxford County Soil to attend a public forum on 1/29/2011.
8. We received some information from the Maine Historical Society stating that they felt there was no issue with the Town Hall being put on the National registry. They are however not making those nominations at this time. They suggested that if we wanted to move forward now instead of waiting until such time as they would be applying again that we contact a historian to do this for us. They supplied us with a list of names.
9. We discussed the proposed new glass/can crusher.
