Selectmen Meeting Minutes

Attendance; Bob Drew, Turf Ramsden, Larry Fox, Tommy McKenzie, Meg Dyer, and Lynn Korth.

1. Accepted May 28, 2013 minutes.
2. Reviewed and signed V.F.W. applications for a License to Operate Games of Chance and Bingo.
3. Reviewed MMWAC monthly activity report.
4. Received K.L.W.A News Letter with an invitation to attend the Annual Membership Meeting July 13, 2013.
5. Larry reported the crew has cleaned up from Sundays storm and their recent project at Pleasant Point controlled the water flow away from the beach as intended.
6. Meg came in to report Rec. Dept. will be switching to summer programs and concerns if we would be required to purchase Parks and Rec. Grade playground equipment for the Rec. Field, also we discussed location options for best use and safety. Meg is looking at doing the playground in stages over a 2 to 3 year period to allow for fund raising.
7. Lynn Korth came in to discuss some concerns with projects at Eastman Hill Rd., and Martins Brook. We have been in contact with D.E.P. and Larry will meet with them regarding these projects and also the Fern Dr. Bridge. Lynn asked to be informed of any progress so as to work cooperatively with projects abutting their property. Lynn also had issues with the Swain Rd. sign and asked that it be placed in the right of way, Larry will move this sign and also the Stop sign at the bottom of Eastman Hill Rd. to a location within the right of way. Lynn also had questions regarding plowing of Swain Rd. Larry informed her the town does not maintain the road for winter travel and any plowing is done privately.

Tommy came in to report fire school is progressing well, also the Town Of Stoneham will install a fire hydrant at the Horseshoe Pond Outlet., we also discussed the possibility of a hydrant at the sucker brook culvert project available water depth is unknown and will be looked at again during the project. Tommy also informed us that I.S.O. are reevaluating the whole state to determine home owner rates and is working with us to reset the mill pond hydrant to possibly lower our rate from 7 to 6.
