1. Approved July 9, 2013 minutes.
2. Received a letter of concern from James R. Bast in regard to lake patrol practices, we will contact KLWA to clarify the job description.
3. Received a letter from Time Warner Cable requesting a forwarding E-mail address for the new Going Green Initiative.
4. Received memorandum from MMWAC announcing the next meeting July 30, 2013.
5. Received a copy of response to Maine State Librarian, Linda Lord's letter to the Lovell Library regarding registration.
6. Received MMA Election Ballot.
7. Lynn Korth came in to discuss schedule for the Martins Brook Project and asked that we inspect ditching work performed adjacent to the Korth's property and view new monumentation pins. We viewed and discussed these projects with Lynn. We motioned and all voted in favor that all issues at present are resolved and we will move ahead with the Martin's Brook Project. We will contact Lynn as soon as a date and time are set. Lynn has agreed to allow machinery to be placed within DEP's suggested area to facilitate removal of sediment causing a restriction in the flow of the brook.
8. Signed a Concealed Firearms Permit.
9. Received a letter from William Noble from DEP in regard to an issue involving work at the mill pond.
10. Discussed school board plans on consolidation of SAD 72 schools, we will ask our school board members to meet with the selectmen that we may be better informed of future plans.
11. We met with Jeffrey Kalinich July 10th for a site inspection of Martin's Brook.
12. Larry reported paving has been completed.
13. Discussed the Sucker Brook project, we may close the road for a couple of days we will notify fire and rescue of our intention as a detour around Union Hill Rd. will be required.
14. Addressed a right of way issue into Howard Pasture to retrieve gravel for the Sucker Brook Project, Larry will continue his attempts to contact abutters.
