Selectmen's Meeting Minutes, November 15, 2011

Attendance - Bob Drew, Turf Ramsden, Stephen Goldsmith, Tom Mckenzie, Scott Davidson and Larry Fox

1. Accepted last week's minutes.
2. Tom Hughes came in and discussed with us Trout Pond. This body of water is in Stoneham and he was questioning LIPCC's responsibility concerning this. Steve suggested that he schedule a meeting with the Stoneham selectmen and inform them of what is going on. We all voted in favor.
3. Scott Davidson came in to tell us that he caught the person taking batteries from our transfer station. We decided to put up new signs worded appropriately so that it was clear that this is not allowed. We will also be closing the gate at the facility.
4. Tom Mckenzie wanted to discuss burning at the transfer station. A lengthy discussion followed. We agreed that we will burn on Mondays and only if the weather is conducive, and we will be more diligent with this. We will work on some standard operating procedures. Tom will issue us permits for this.
5. We discussed the stump dump and some issues we are having. A key will be given out after collecting the name of the contractor as well as the person's name of where the material has come from. The maximum number of days a key can be out is 3 days. Starting in 2012 we will have some new procedures.
6. Steve received his MMA grant for safety equipment.
7. We discussed our present policy regarding putting projects out to bid. It was felt that this needs to be adjusted a little so Bob made the motion and Turf seconded it that all projects under \$10,000.00 do not have to go out to bid. This is an increase from \$5,000.00. We all voted in favor.
8. Bob's Tire has picked up a load of tires from our transfer station. The cost is \$.75 per tire.
9. Larry talked with the loggers for the Korth's and their forester about the need for them to fix the culvert on 5A that has been damaged. It needs to be completed before winter.
