

Town Of Lovell

Selectmen's meeting minutes December 20, 2011

Attendance: Turf Ramsden, Bob Drew and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox, Tom McKenzie and Gene Spender were also present.

1. We accepted last week's minutes, all voted in favor.
2. We received some ordinance wording changes from the Planning Board. We will need further clarification on this. Bob will speak to Ed Ryan.
3. Larry reported to us on prices for a new plow truck. The cab and chassis is between \$98,000.00 and \$110,000.00. (theses are Freightliner, Western Star, and International) The plow and body complete will be about \$70,000.00. Our old International is only worth about \$12,000.00.
4. Larry reported to us on the prices of 8x8x16 for boards for the mill pond dam. They are \$51.00 each. The project will be around \$1,500.00 to \$2,000.00.
5. The ramp at the No. Lovell Station will cost about \$6,000.00. The pad at the center station will be about \$1,000.00.
6. The cost to do the parking lot at the library is estimated at about \$5,000.00.
7. We received a late budget request.
8. We discussed the Town Hall and the work we are doing.
9. We received the minutes as well as the audit from MMWAC.
10. Gene Spender came in to discuss the pay for Marty Proux. He was paid last year \$13.00 per hour and the LIPPC Committee would like to increase his pay to \$14.50. Bob made the motion and Turf seconded it. We all voted in favor. Marty has done an exceptional job.
11. We discussed the LIPPC committee's budget request.
12. Tom McKenzie discussed with us the Fire Departments budget and the rational behind it. The total original request was for \$122,455.00. We discussed this and Tom McKenzie stated that he would rework the budget and present to us a new corrected one.
13. We reviewed all other budget requests as well. We looked over our ending balances to date. We have only two (2) accounts that are overdrawn for a total of \$145.41.
