Selectmen Meeting Minutes

July 1, 2014

1. Approved June 24, 2014 minutes.
2. Reviewed 67th Annual Maine Property Tax School courses offered for 2014.
3. Reviewed a letter from MSAD72 regarding a response to the state process required under 20-A, S1255, SUB-53 changes in apportionment. A committee of 1. One municipal officer 2. One citizen at large 3. One school board member, will be formed for a July 14, 2014 committee meeting.
4. Reviewed and signed a license to operate a Game of Chance for the V.F.W.
5. Kevin Harding came in to request the placement of collection containers at the town boat landings (6). The containers are for the collection of used fishing line in an attempt to help local fish and wildlife entanglement. Kevin will oversee installment and disposal, we all agreed (3-0).
6. Stan came in to discuss preparations for Lovell Old Home Days, Oxford County Sheriffs Department will provide traffic aid, we are not allowed to close any roads, expect delays and detour signs are allowed.
7. Meg came in to report on the Lovell Rec. Dept. We discussed the possibility of a summer day care program, similar. to Brownfields current program. We also discussed Emergency Injury Procedure, emergency training may be required as well as a background check. MMA forms are available at the Town Office. The Lovell Rec. Committee will be better informed on the use of forms and procedures. We will work out a plan going forward to provide employees with a packet explaining the requirements.
8. Gene came in to discuss the possibility of a non-resident town meeting, we agreed that if such a meeting was requested we would set a time at a regular Tuesday selectmen meeting to help answer any questions or concerns non-residents may like to present to the selectmen.
9. Discussed Transfer Station shipping schedule due to the July 4th holiday, Larry will make arrangements for placement of another container over the weekend if needed.
10. Docks have been installed at the West Lovell Landing.
11. Tommie reported on inspection of the firehouse doors that the headers above are rotted and in need of replacement, we discussed the formula governing costs. The cost will be put forth in an article at the 2015 Town Meeting for a maintenance budget, Tommie will formulate a plan and spec's, a plan to raise the doors two feet to accomadate the height of new equipment will also be included.
