June 9, 2015

Attendance; Turf Ramsden, Steve Goldsmith, Bob Drew, Larry Fox, Tommie McKenzie, and Scott Gardiner.

1. Reviewed and signed the Warrant.
2. Reviewed and signed the Ratio Declaration and Reimbursement Application.
3. Reviewed Practitioners Report Workers Compensation Board update on injured employee Scott Gardiner, we agreed more healing time was needed and asked to be informed on his next exam and evaluation before being allowed back to work.
4. Reviewed Real Estate Transfer Tax Declarations.
5. Reviewed Builders Risk Policy for the Salt Sand Shed Project.
6. Reviewed MSAD#72 Board of Directors Meeting Agenda for June 10, 2015.
7. Tommie reported on LVFD, the following courses have been completed by various members, Community Risk Issues and Prevention Interventions, Fire Chief – Challenging Issues, Next-Gen Fire Command Officer Program, Emergency Scene Traffic Control Training, Communications Governing Board Meeting, and Alternative Learning Day. Training scheduled for Chain Saw Safety, Wildland Fire Control, and Fire Hose Testing. Four calls were answered, Charlotte Hobbs Library was toured, and an application for a King Grant was filed.
8. Larry reported on Public Works, spoke with MDOT regarding posting of the Narrows Bridge, we asked that he put together impact statistics for traffic, businesses, homes, and contractors affected by the posting and the states idea to use the Westside Rd. as an alternative route for trucks restricted from bridge posting. A contract was signed for the Salt Sand Shed Project with Drew Corp. Discussed the cost of excavation on the towns participation towards the Salt Sand Shed Project. Discussed estimate for chain-link fencing for the No. Lovell Cemetery, \$4,000 - \$6,000, it was decided we would make an onsite inspection to determine what options may also be available such as a wooden fence or post and chain. The Narrows Boat Ramp will be temporarily filled with stone and a price for replacement will be needed for the 2016 budget.
