

LIPPC Minutes 10-24-19

Attendees and volunteer hours: Sue-2, Jill-1, Diane-4, Marty-15, Tim-3, Dave-10, Doug-2, Ed-2, Jay-1

Meeting started at 5:30. Minutes from last meeting were approved.

CBI. Marty presented yr end Boat Inspection statistics. Inspections were down about 5% over previous year. Volunteer inspection hours were down for the year. Wash station at Narrows was used more this season than in past. Shed is locked for season.

There was discussion of who owns boat wash station. Consensus was that it is currently 'owned' by KLWA and that it makes more sense for LIPPC to have responsibility for maintenance and ownership. Ed will discuss with KLWA at their next meeting and suggest that LIPPC take responsibility.

Education. Sue reports that some new stewards have asked for a workshop later in the year so we could review more mature plants in our waters. She suggests a 'Paddle with a Buddy' program may encourage more collaboration during the season among stewards. There was discussion of a field trip to a local water body to view invasives directly. All agree that it would be best to view from shore or wading so that we don't contaminate our watercraft and bring back to Kezar watershed.

Cushman. Will supply grant information by year end for next year's grant. We have 1 year and 2 more to go in order to be removed from State list for 'milfoil free.'

Treasurer. Dave presented Treasurer's report through 10-21-19. Report discussed funding, donations and budget for 2020. All sub committees will present budget requests at next meeting. Committee is adequately funded for coming year. Minimum wage to increase from \$11 to \$12 next year.

Next meeting Nov 21st at 5:30. There will be no December meeting.
