We are erring on the side of caution in order to do our best to slow the spread of this virus.

The following measures will be implemented as of Tuesday, March 17th at noon until April 1st (if circumstances warrant that time period will be extended):

Fire Department – The public use of the meeting room will be discontinued as this serves as the Town's emergency Shelter. Burn permits can be obtained online.

Transfer Station – The transfer station will remain open for normal hours, however, personnel will practice social distancing of at least six feet, and will not be able to assist with unloading trash or other items.

Public Works – Public Works personnel will continue to work however there will be no public access to the Town Garage. Persons with road concerns or questions should call the highway garage and questions will be answered (207-925-1010)

Recreation – All recreation programs are cancelled until April 1st.

Code Enforcement – Those wishing to get building permits or who have questions regarding projects should call the town office at 207-925-6272 and we will be processing as much as possible via phone, email, and regular mail.

General Assistance – Persons seeking general assistance should call the Town Office at 207-925-6272 and we will process applications over the phone.

Town Office – The town office will be closed to the public as of Tuesday, March 17th but staff will be working and people are asked to call the Town Office at 207-925-6272 and we will do our best to provide the services that you require.

It is possible to re-register vehicles, ATVs, boats, register dogs, and get hunting and fishing licenses online. Links are provided on the towns' website (If you have a new vehicle to register, please contact the Town Office to make arrangements.)

Select Board – The Select Board will continue to meet for operational purposes, with a limited agenda.

Other Town Boards/Committees - Non-essential committee and board meetings are encouraged to postpone their meetings but will be individually evaluated in advance of their meeting to gauge the implications of meeting or not meeting.
